Each question is worth equal marks
and should not exceed a 2,500 word limit.

- There are FIVE questions presented in the Dynamic Techniques Examination. You are required to answer a total of **THREE** questions:
- Your **CANDIDATE NUMBER** must be placed on the **top right corner of each page**. Do not show your name on ANY of your papers, charts or computer printouts. If using Solar Fire Charts, ensure Solar Fire “Chart Page Compliments Text” does not contain your name, or is turned off.
- Each answer should have the question stated at the beginning of the essay.
- The word length should be stated at the end of each essay (introduction, body, conclusion, footnotes, references and appendices).
- Two (2) printed copies **OR** one (1) digital copy plus one (1) printed copy of each of your answer papers must be returned to the Exam Board Director.
- Each question must be presented as a complete unit. The printed form needs to be stapled together - no loose papers please. The digital format must be sent as one whole document, the document must include all the supporting material, ie charts, transit graphs, etc. PDF format is preferable.
- Your answers must be returned to the Exam Board Director, postmarked and/or emailed **no later than Tuesday the 2nd November 2010**. We recommend using Express Post to minimise the risk of lost or delayed exam papers.
- Once the examination commences and you then decide that due to personal circumstances you will not be completing the exam, please advise the Exam Board Director ASAP.

OTHER INFORMATION

This is an unsupervised examination. You may use a computer program to generate any or all of your data, however, please include details of your software in your bibliography. All sources of information used in your research must be included in your bibliography, including quotations. Quotations should also be referenced within the text of your essay. Plagiarism will result in failure of the exam, so all sources must be acknowledged.

Examiners will be marking on the validity of your argument, not right or wrong answers. You must also demonstrate the use of counselling skills which support the client. All statements made in your answers need to be supported with Astrological reasoning.

You may use any form or chart style or 90 degree dial.

Each essay must comply with a maximum word limit of up to 2,500 words with a +/- 10% tolerance. You will be assessed on your astrological knowledge with consideration given to your ability to write a properly structured, succinct and academic work which may (with consent) later be published in the FAA Journal. The 2,500 word limit applies to the essay's Introduction, Body and Conclusion, this includes any footnotes, references or appendices. Any title page, charts, tables and bibliography are not included in the word limit.

Essays should be typed and double line spaced using a font such as Times New Roman, Arial or Trebuchet.

Be sure to state your astrological reasoning throughout your answers. Ensure you include all charts generated with your answers and **ensure you have cast the correct chart from the data supplied.**

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Question 1.

The Progressed Lunation Phases track the unfoldment and creative development in our lives as we instinctively reach toward our potential.

Identify the present progressed moon phases for these two clients. How you would go about counselling and empowering each of them for further fulfilment of their soul's growth and potential in the future? Include relevant transits and secondary progressions only if applicable.

Birth data Mary: born 5 Jan 1940 at 6.05 pm in Brisbane.
Her Ascendant is closer to 5 degrees Cancer.

Mary was married to her second husband for 35 years. He died from cancer in 2007 and she wants to know what is on the horizon for her as she feels the urge to move forwards in her life.

Birth data Elizabeth: born 2 May 1936 at 7.10 am in Sydney.
Her Ascendant is closer to 19 degrees Taurus.

Elizabeth has been married to her husband for 54 years. He is in a nursing home with Alzheimer's and numerous other chronic health problems. One of her sons is not coping with his father's condition and refuses to visit him in the nursing home. Elizabeth feels her life is on hold and wants to know when she can 'expect light at the end of the tunnel.'

Question 2.

Birth Data: Kate 16 April 1980 12.55 pm Adelaide, Australia
Her Ascendant is closer to 16 Cancer

Kate is looking for guidance in the areas of career, wealth, relationships and health. She is seeking confirmation that the timing is right for several very specific plans.

1. Would like to profitably sell her home as soon as possible in order to quit her job and study full- time.
2. Having just started 'trading live' wants to get to the stage where it's providing sufficient income before her savings run out.
3. Is currently studying naturopathy and would like to educate others in a revolutionary way.
4. Has a goal of developing a business with a website that reflects her philosophy.

Examining Kate's Solar Return Charts for 2010 and 2011, how would you go about answering her questions and empowering her to make the right decisions in her inquired 'areas of life'. Kate lives in Melbourne.

Question 3:

Birth Data: Meg 2 March 1951 9.30 am Melbourne, Victoria
Her Ascendant is closer to 21 Aries

Meg is in a confused state that fluctuates between elation, high anxiety and fear. She has recently taken on an exciting new position at work but admits she is finding the added book work somewhat stressful. During 2009 he proposed to his partner and embarked on a new career in real estate after letting go his long cherished dream of making a living as a musician. He and his fiancée have just bought a home and are planning their wedding for September 2011. Question 5:

Birth Data: Lucy 12 June 1968 2.25 pm Adelaide, NSW
Her Ascendant is closer to 4 Scorpio

Lucy is in the middle of the Mid-Life transition which is powerfully reflected in the circumstances of her life. Throughout 2009 she felt trapped and exploited in her work for a large interior design company and finally found the courage to move on to another company, only to be made redundant a few months later.
