Moon	opp Sun, square Saturn, quincunx Neptune, square Pluto, sext Chiron, con NN, opp SN
Sun	square Saturn, square Pluto, trine Chiron, opp NN, con SN
Mercury	con Venus, trine Mars, square Jupiter, sext Uranus, trine ASC
Venus	trine Mars, square Jupiter, sext Uranus, trine ASC, quincunx MC
Mars	con ASC, square MC
Jupiter	trine MC
Saturn	sext Neptune, con Pluto, quincunx Chiron, square NN, square SN
Uranus	sext ASC
Neptune	sext Pluto, quincunx NN
Pluto	square NN, square SN

Q2 Aspect Pattern = **T square** with Sun/South Node opp Moon/North Node square Saturn and Pluto

Q3 Planet closest to Angle = **Mars**

Q4 Lunation Phase = **Full Moon Phase**

Moon is 182 degrees 06 minutes ahead of Sun – start of Full Moon Phase

OR Moon is 177.54 behind the Sun

Q5 Midpoint of Venus / Jupiter

Venus	7 Aquarius 09	307.09
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Jupiter	7 Scorpio 17	<u>217.17</u>

Divide by 2	44.56
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Add to smaller figure	<u>217.17</u>
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262.13 =

Therefore **Short Arc midpoint = 22 Sagittarius 13**

Q6 Vertex = Subtract latitude of birth from 90 degrees 90 00 – 51.28 = 38.32 is new lat.

Chart IC for Northern latitudes = 10 Capricorn 31

Look this up in Table of Houses: Go down ASC column to 39 degrees latitude

Halfway between 10 Cap 07 & 11 Cap 02 is answer.

Subtract 18 Aries 15 from 19 Cap 52 = 1 degree 37 min (divide by 2 = 48'

Vertex = 18 Aries 48 (same as Computer calculation)

Q7 **Saturn is exalted in Libra**

Q1 Secondary Progressed Moon table for Kate 2011 29 years old
 ACD using midnight ephemeris is 15th January 1981 (year before)
 So Ephemeris Date for 2011 Progressions = 8th February 1982

Q2 29 years old 2011 (She was born on 9th so count forward from 10/1/1982 in ephemeris to 8 Feb where Prog Sun & Prog Moon are opposite each other = 30 years minus 1 year because ACD is Jan 1981 = 29)

Q3 17 years old 1999 (Count forward from 10/1/82 down Sun column to 7 Aq 09 (Venus' Position = 18 yrs minus 1 year ACD 1981 = 17)

Q4 2007

Step 1:

To form the conjunction 'aspect' S.A. Jupiter must reach : 3 Sag 08 (Natal Uranus) = 243 08		
Subtract Natal position of S.A. planet	7 Scor 17	= <u>217 17</u>
		<u>25 51</u>

<i>Step 2:</i>	Natal Sun's position	19 Cap 23	= 289 23
	Add Solar Arc Answer - Step 1		<u>25 51</u>
	Required Sun Position		315 14 = 15 Aq 14

Now check this position of Required Solar Arc Sun in ephemeris - **go down Sun column**. Count down years from GMT DOB to give you the age.

Find **Sun 15 Aq 14 = 26 yrs - minus 1 year = 25 yrs (2007)**

Step 4: Do ACD adjustment by subtracting one year if ACD falls in the year before!
