The Calculation Exam is to be completed under supervision.

Time allowed for the Exam is 3 ½ hours.

The Exam is divided into three sections:

Section 1 consists of TWO questions on the calculation of natal chart angles, house cusps and planets. Both questions in this section must be completed. Suggested time allocation for this section is 1 hour. (30 Marks)

Section 2 consists of EIGHT questions on aspects and other appropriate information given in the natal chart. All questions must be answered. Suggested time allocation for this section is 1 hour. (30 Marks)

Section 3 contains TEN questions on the calculation of Transits, Progressions and Directions in the horoscope. All questions must be answered. Suggested time allocation for this section is 1½ hour. (40 Marks)

- Please ensure all answers are written on these sheets.
- **Attach all working papers and scribble sheets** to the Answer Sheets and hand them to the supervisor when you have finished.

The overall pass mark for this exam is 60%. Candidates must also achieve a minimum mark of 50% in each of Sections 1, 2 & 3 of the Exam in order to gain an overall pass.

Standard Time Zone: + 5 hours (West of Greenwich) **10 marks**
No Daylight Savings

(b) 19th August 1959 2.20 am
Wollongong NSW 34S26 150E53
Standard Time Zone - 10 hours (East of Greenwich) **10 marks**
No Daylight Savings

Q2 Calculate the longitudinal positions of the following planets to within 30 minutes of zodiacal longitude. All data below is in GMT.

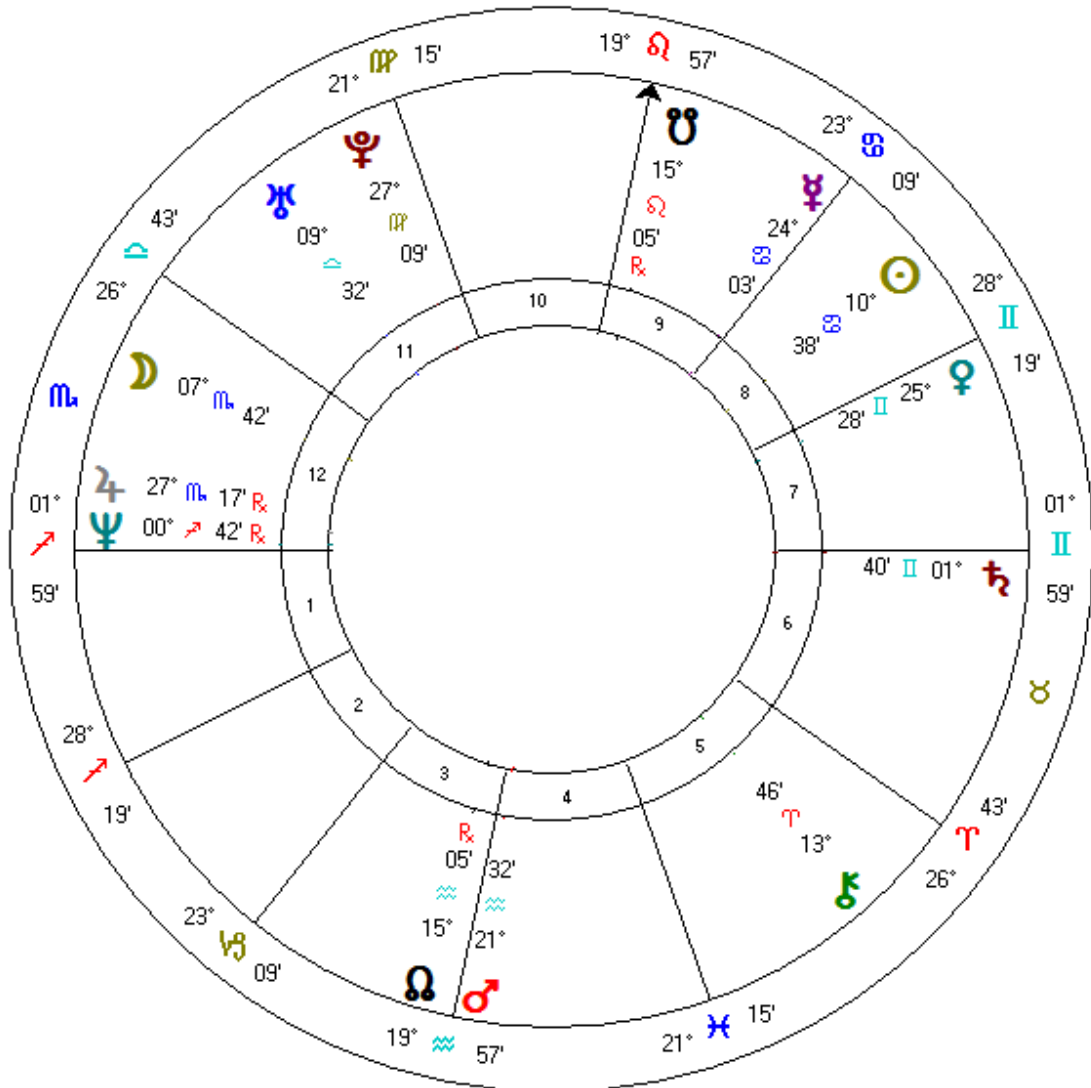
1. Sun: 15 December 1984 10.15 pm
2. Moon 7 November 1926 5.30 pm
3. Mercury: 11 June 1956 9.15 pm
4. Venus: 21 February 1953 5.20 am
5. Mars: 7 November 1926 5.30 pm **10 marks**

SECTION 2 – Total 30 Marks

- Q1 Using the aspect grid supplied, find only the following aspects using the stated maximum orbs. 14 marks
Use the planets plus Chiron and the Nodes and ASC and MC

| Conjunction | – 8 degree orb. |
| Square | – 8 degree orb. |
| Opposition | – 8 degree orb. |
| Trine | – 8 degree orb. |
| Sextile | – 6 degree orb. |
| Quincunx | – 4 degree orb. |
- Q2 Using Planets, Chiron and the Nodes only name 1 aspect pattern formed and identify the planets/points that form it. 2 marks
- Q3 What is the Lunation Phase for this chart? 3 marks
- Q4 Using the diurnal formula, calculate the Part of Fortune to the nearest Degree. 3 marks
- Q5 Which planet/s fall/s within an angular house? 1 mark
- Q6 What is the short arc midpoint of the Sun and Jupiter? 3 marks
- Q7 Which 2 planets form the most exact major aspect? 1 marks
- Q8 Which house/s does Mercury rule? 3 marks

All questions in this section relate to Julian's chart, except for Questions 8 and 10.
All answers to be in GMT.

Midnight ephemeris: ACD = 18 April 1971 Noon ephemeris: ACD = 17 October

- Q1 Calculate a [12] monthly Secondary Progressed Moon table for Julian for 2013, starting from January 18 to the nearest 30 minutes of arc. 6 marks
- Q2 How old will Julian be when he experiences his second secondary progressed New Moon? What degree and sign is it in? 4 marks
- Q3 At what age was Julian when his Progressed Sun conjuncted his natal Midheaven? 3 marks
- Q4 How old will Julian be when Solar Arc Pluto is conjunct natal Moon in his chart? 4 marks
- Q5 List the exact GMT dates in 2013 when transiting Pluto opposes Julian's natal Sun. 3 marks
- Q6 Using a 1 degree orb, list the current periods when transiting Saturn conjuncts Julian's Moon. 3 marks
- Q7 List the exact GMT date[s] when Julian experiences his Uranus opposition. 3 marks
- Q8 List the GMT dates and zodiacal degrees of all solar and lunar eclipses for 2014. 6 marks
- Q9 How old will Julian be when Progressed Venus opposes his natal Mars? 4 marks
- Q10 Calculate the GMT **Adjusted Calculation Date** for the following birth data: 4 marks

September 16th 1973 3.40pm Richmond Virginia USA

Standard Time Zone : + 4 hours

No Daylight Savings
