Not returning your working out sheets may result in less marks and possibly not passing, as only your answer to a question can be marked.

Remember to be clear and legible and use BLACK PEN. Please number each of your personal calculation pages and answers so they clearly link back to the relevant question for easy cross referencing.

(20 Marks)
Section 3 contains TEN questions on the calculation of Transits, Progressions and Directions in the horoscope. All questions must be answered.
(30 Marks)
Section 4 consists of TWENTY-FIVE multiple choice questions. You must answer TWENTY of them.
